TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On behalf of South Broward Drainage District, I would like to inform you that Intercounty Engineering, Inc., successfully completed the District's primary stormwater pump station known as the S-4/5 Pump Station.

This project was multifaceted and included major excavation work with the installation of approximately \$1,000,000 in sheet piling, underground culverts varying in size from 36 inches in diameter to 96 inches in diameter. The project also included a 2,000 square foot block building which houses a series of engines to operate pumps for discharging stormwater. The building, in addition, also included sophisticated electronic monitoring equipment including telemetry to operate the station under all weather conditions. The total contract price for the project was \$3,014,672.

The District and the residents within the S-4/5 Basins can be proud of this new facility which will provide enhanced flood protection in the time of a major storm event.
